

## CANADA AVIATION ACADEMY Student Statement of Rights

<u>Canada Aviation Academy</u> (CAAI) is designated with the <u>Private Training Institutions</u> <u>Branch</u> (PTIB) of the British Columbia Ministry of Advanced Education and Skills Training.

Before you enrol with us, you should be aware of your rights and responsibilities:

- 1) You have the right to be treated fairly and respectfully by the institution.
- 2) You have the right to a Student Enrolment Contract that includes the following information:
  - a) Amount of tuition and any additional fee for your program
  - b) Refund policy
  - c) Dispute resolution policy (You have the right to access the institution's dispute resolution process and to be protected against retaliation for making a complaint.)
  - d) Whether the program is approved by PTIB or does not require approval.
  - e) Make sure you read the contract before signing. CAAI must provide you with a signed copy.
- 3) You have the right to make a claim to PTIB for a tuition refund if:
  - a) CAAI ceased to hold a PTIB Designation certificate before you completed an approved program.
  - b) You were misled about a significant aspect of your approved program.
- 4) You must file the claim within one year of completing, being dismissed or withdrawing from your program.
